3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.94.544 and 2008 c 68 s 3 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 The requirements of this section and RCW 19.94.540 and 19.94.542
7 shall not apply to the sale of a motor vehicle that contains engine
8 coolant or antifreeze (~~(or to wholesale containers of fifty-five~~
9 ~~gallons or more of engine coolant or antifreeze)~~).
