4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECT</u>ION. 5 **sec. 1.** (1) The department of transportation shall 6 enqaqe in transparent, public process to reexamine the а administrative rules surrounding access to high occupancy vehicle 7 lanes that must include an examination of the benefits and impacts of 8 9 allowing private, for hire vehicles regulated under chapter 81.72 RCW 10 that have been specially manufactured, designed, or modified for the 11 transportation of a person who has a mobility disability and uses a 12 wheelchair or other assistive device into the high occupancy vehicle 13 lanes.

14 (2) By January 1, 2018, the department of transportation shall 15 report progress of the public rule reexamination process in 16 subsection (1) of this section to the transportation committees of 17 the legislature with sufficient time for review before the conclusion 18 of the process.

19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act expires August 1, 2019.
