- 6 Territory within a cemetery district may be withdrawn from the 7 district in the same manner provided by law for withdrawal of
- 8 territory from water-sewer districts, as provided by chapter 57.28
- 9 RCW, except that no territory within a cemetery district may be
- 10 withdrawn unless a special election is held and a majority of votes
- 11 cast by qualified voters residing within the district approve the
- 12 withdrawal. Agreement between the district board of commissioners and
- 13 the county legislative authority on the findings of fact under RCW
- 14 57.28.080 does not preclude an election under this section.
