1 On page 2, line 28, after "operate" strike "one or more  
2 recreational facilities other than a ski area" and insert "an  
3 aquatics facility"

4 On page 2, line 29, after "area;" insert "and"

5 On page 2, beginning on line 30, after "(ii)" strike all material  
6 through "(iii)" on line 33

7 On page 3, after line 27, insert the following:

8 "**Sec. 2.** RCW 82.14.0455 and 2010 c 105 s 3 are each amended to  
9 read as follows:

10 (1) Subject to the provisions in RCW 36.73.065, a transportation  
11 benefit district under chapter 36.73 RCW may fix and impose a sales  
12 and use tax in accordance with the terms of this chapter. The tax  
13 authorized in this section is in addition to any other taxes  
14 authorized by law and shall be collected from those persons who are  
15 taxable by the state under chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW upon the  
16 occurrence of any taxable event within the boundaries of the  
17 district. The rate of tax shall not exceed two-tenths of one percent  
18 of the selling price in the case of a sales tax, or value of the  
19 article used, in the case of a use tax. Except as provided in  
20 subsection (2) of this section, the tax may not be imposed for a  
21 period exceeding ten years. This tax, if not imposed under the  
22 conditions of subsection (2) of this section, may be extended for a  
23 period not exceeding ten years with an affirmative vote of the voters  
24 voting at the election.

25 (2) The voter-approved sales tax initially imposed under this  
26 section after July 1, 2010, may be imposed for a period exceeding ten  
27 years if the moneys received under this section are dedicated for the  
28 repayment of indebtedness incurred in accordance with the  
29 requirements of chapter 36.73 RCW.

30 (3) Money received from the tax imposed under this section must  
31 be spent in accordance with the requirements of chapter 36.73 RCW.

1       (4) Money received from the tax imposed under this section in a  
2 public facilities district created under RCW 35.57.010(1)(a) by a  
3 city or town that participated in the creation of an additional  
4 public facilities district under RCW 35.57.010(1)(e) may be utilized  
5 to acquire, construct, own, remodel, maintain, equip, reequip,  
6 repair, finance, and operate an aquatics facility."

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7       On page 1, line 5 of the title, after "35.57.020" insert "and  
8 82.14.0455"

EFFECT: Removes new sales tax authorization and provides authority to utilize existing local option tax to finance PFD aquatics center.

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
