- **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.52.070 and 1994 c 154 s 107 are each amended to 4 5 read as follows:
- 6 Except as required to perform duties within the scope 7 employment, no state officer or state employee may use his or her
- position to secure special privileges or exemptions for himself or 8
- herself, or his or her spouse, child, parents, or other persons. As 9
- 10 used in this section, "special privileges" includes, without
- 11 limitation, securing or seeking to secure unwanted or unwelcome
- romantic, personal, or sexual attention or favors from staff or any 12
- 13 other person.
