- 1 AN ACT Relating to antifouling paints on recreational water
- 2 vessels; amending RCW 70.300.020; and adding new sections to chapter
- 3 70.300 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.300.020 and 2018 c 94 s 3 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) Beginning January 1, ((2021)) 2026, no manufacturer, 8 wholesaler, retailer, or distributor may sell or offer for sale in 9 this state any new recreational water vessel manufactured on or after 10 January 1, ((2021)) 2026, with antifouling paint containing copper. 11 This restriction does not apply to wood boats.
- 12 (2) Beginning January 1, ((2021)) 2026, antifouling paint that is 13 intended for use on a recreational water vessel and that contains 14 more than 0.5 percent copper may not be offered for sale in this 15 state.
- 16 (3) Beginning January 1, ((2021)) 2026, antifouling paint containing more than 0.5 percent copper may not be applied to a recreational water vessel in this state. This restriction does not apply to wood boats.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 70.300 RCW to read as follows:
- Beginning January 1, 2023, antifouling paint that contains the chemical cybutryne, chemical abstracts service registration number
- 5 28159-98-0, may not be offered in this state for use on a
- 6 recreational water vessel.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 70.300 RCW to read as follows:
- 9 (1) The department may require a manufacturer, wholesaler, or 10 retailer of antifouling paints or related substances to submit a 11 notice to the department containing the following information:
- 12 (a) A list of products, including a brief description of each 13 product or product component containing the substance;
- 14 (b) Product ingredients, including the names of the chemicals 15 used or produced and applicable chemical abstracts service registry 16 numbers;
  - (c) Information regarding exposure and chemical hazard;
- 18 (d) A description of the function of each chemical in the 19 product;
- 20 (e) The amount of the chemical used in each unit of the product 21 or product component;
- 22 (f) The name and address of the manufacturer and the name, 23 address, and phone number of a contact person for the manufacturer;
  - (g) Any other information the manufacturer deems relevant to the appropriate use of the product; and
    - (h) Any other information requested by the department.
- 27 (2) The manufacturer must provide the notice required in 28 subsection (1) of this section to the department no later than six 29 months after receipt of such a demand by the department.
