- 2 professional licensure requirements; and adding a new section to

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.24 6 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) An active duty military spouse may engage in the practice of a profession regulated by the department of licensing without obtaining a Washington state certificate, registration, license, or
- 10 permit if the spouse is:
 - (a) Stationed in Washington;
- 12 (b) Certified, registered, or licensed, or has a permit to 13 perform such professional services in another state;
 - (c) In good standing in the state of licensure; and
- 15 (d) Not subject to any pending investigation, charges, or 16 disciplinary action by the regulatory body of another state.
- 17 (2) For the purposes of this section:
- 18 (a) "Military spouse" means any person married to an active or
- 19 reserve member in any branch of the armed forces of the United
- 20 States, including the national guard, coast guard, and merchant
