1 AN ACT Relating to the membership of the criminal justice 2 training commission; and amending RCW 43.101.030.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.101.030 and 1999 c 97 s 1 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The commission shall consist of ((fourteen)) sixteen members, who 7 shall be selected as follows:

8 (1) The governor shall appoint two incumbent sheriffs and two 9 incumbent chiefs of police.

10 (2) The governor shall appoint one officer at or below the level 11 of first line supervisor from a county law enforcement agency and one 12 officer at or below the level of first line supervisor from a 13 municipal law enforcement agency. Each appointee under this 14 subsection (2) shall have at least ten years experience as a law 15 enforcement officer.

16 (3) The governor shall appoint one person employed in a county 17 correctional system and one person employed in the state correctional 18 system.

(4) The governor shall appoint one incumbent county prosecutingattorney or municipal attorney.

1 (5) The governor shall appoint one elected official of a local 2 government.

3 (6) The governor shall appoint ((one)) two private citizens, one 4 from east of the crest of the Cascade mountains and one from west of 5 the crest of the Cascade mountains. At least one of the private 6 citizens must be from a historically underrepresented community or 7 communities.

8 (7) <u>The governor shall appoint one tribal chair, board member,</u> 9 <u>councilmember, or designee from a federally recognized tribe with an</u> 10 <u>active certification agreement under RCW 43.101.157.</u>

11 (8) The three remaining members shall be:

12 (a) The attorney general;

13 (b) The special agent in charge of the Seattle office of the 14 federal bureau of investigation; and

15 (c) The chief of the state patrol.
