- 1 AN ACT Relating to supporting veterans service organizations;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 43.60A RCW; creating a new section;
- 3 and providing an expiration date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that congressionally chartered veterans service organizations provide valuable support to veterans and their families, who have selflessly and bravely served
- 8 our country. The legislature further finds that these organizations
- 9 are at a distinct economic disadvantage in comparison to other
- 10 membership-based organizations because membership requires qualifying
- 11 military service and the organizations often rely heavily on their
- 12 elderly and disabled veteran member-patrons economically. Therefore,
- 13 the legislature intends to find ways to support veterans service
- 14 organizations and the valuable services they provide.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.60A
- 16 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 (1) The department shall study and make recommendations on ways
- 18 to strengthen the financial viability of congressionally chartered
- 19 veterans service organizations. The department must review the
- 20 availability of state and local programs, including tax incentives,

- 1 to veterans service organizations and recommend best practices to
- 2 increase participation. The department shall submit, in compliance
- 3 with RCW 43.01.036, a report of recommendations to the joint
- 4 committee on veterans' and military affairs and other appropriate
- 5 committees of the legislature by December 1, 2021.
