3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.50.535 and 2017 c 93 s 1 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 A community or technical college may issue a high school diploma
7 or certificate as provided under this section.

8 (1) An individual who satisfactorily meets the requirements for
9 high school completion shall be awarded a diploma from the college,
10 subject to rules adopted by the superintendent of public instruction
11 and the state board of education.

12 ~~(2) ((An individual enrolled through the option established under
13 RCW 28A.600.310 through 28A.600.400 who satisfactorily completes an
14 associate degree, including an associate of arts degree, associate of
15 science degree, associate of technology degree, or associate in
