- 1 AN ACT Relating to the classification of heavy equipment rental
- property as inventory; adding a new section to chapter 84.36 RCW; and
- 3 creating new sections.

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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 84.36 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 All heavy equipment rental property owned by a heavy equipment rental property dealer is exempt from taxation. 8
- (2) The definitions in this subsection apply throughout this 9 10 section unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- 11 (a) (i) "Heavy equipment rental property" means any equipment that 12 is rented by a heavy equipment rental property dealer that:
- (A) Is mobile. For purposes of this subsection, "mobile" means 14 that the heavy equipment property is not permanently affixed to real 15 property and is moved among worksites as needed;
- (B) Is used for construction or industrial applications. For the 16 17 this subsection, "construction of or 18 applications" means that the rental equipment is used by a heavy 19 equipment rental property dealer in the ordinary course of their 20 business; and
- 21 (C) Is rented without an operator.

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- 1 (ii) "Heavy equipment rental property" includes, but is not 2 limited to the following:
- 3 (A) Earthmoving equipment, including but not limited to backhoes, 4 loaders, rollers, excavators, bulldozers, and dump trucks;
- 5 (B) Self-propelled vehicles that are not designed to be driven on 6 the highway;
 - (C) Industrial electrical generation equipment;
- 8 (D) Industrial lift equipment;

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- (E) Industrial material handling equipment;
- 10 (F) Equipment used in shoring, shielding, and ground trenching;
- 11 (G) Portable power and HVAC generation equipment;
- 12 (H) Attachments to heavy equipment rental property, including but 13 not limited to buckets, augers, hammers for backhoes, hoses, 14 fittings, piping, chains, tools (such as jack hammers and cement 15 chippers), and portable power connections;
- (I) Ancillary equipment, including but not limited to generators, ground thawing equipment, fluid transfer equipment, pumping equipment, portable storage, portable fuel and water tanks, and light towers; and
- 20 (J) Equipment or vehicles not subject to vehicle license fees and 21 not required to be registered with the department of licensing.
- 22 (iii) "Heavy equipment rental property" does not include small 23 hand tools, chainsaws, or lawnmowers.
- 24 (b) "Heavy equipment rental property dealer" means a person principally engaged in the business of renting heavy equipment rental property. For purposes of this subsection, "principally" means that the heavy equipment rental property dealer receives more than fifty percent of the dealer's annual total revenue from the rental of heavy equipment rental property.
- 30 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act applies to taxes levied for 31 collection in 2022 and thereafter.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The provisions of RCW 82.32.805 and 82.32.808 do not apply to this act.

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
