

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2020-4677, by Representatives Orcutt and DeBolt

1 WHEREAS, The Onalaska Loggers high school football team, under
2 the leadership of Coach Mazen Saade, finished the 2019 season with a
3 perfect 13-0 record; and

4 WHEREAS, The Loggers defeated the very tough Kalama Chinook team
5 by a score of 48-30 on Saturday, December 7, 2019, at Harry E. Lang
6 Stadium in Lakewood, WA; and

7 WHEREAS, No team had scored that many points in a title game
8 since 1998; and

9 WHEREAS, The Loggers fought tooth and nail to bring home their
10 first state championship in 33 years; and

11 WHEREAS, Onalaska played in what was, without question, the
12 toughest division in the state, with three 2B League Mountain
13 Division teams making the state semifinals; and

14 WHEREAS, In their five games against these Mountain Division
15 opponents, the Loggers scored an average of 46.8 points a game and
16 gave up an average of only 9.8; and

17 WHEREAS, The Loggers' impressive year was led by their five
18 senior captains and All-State Players Hazen Inman, Cade Lawrence,
19 Lucas Kreger, Alex Frazier, and Ashton Haight; and

20 WHEREAS, Fullback Ashton Haight ran for 2,714 yards on 345
21 carries and scored 35 touchdowns, logging an incredible 7.86 yards
22 per carry; and

1 WHEREAS, Ashton's rushing total was the fifth-highest total over
2 the course of a season in state history; and

3 WHEREAS, The Onalaska Loggers' toughness and resolve, both
4 offensively and defensively, earned them the nickname "Grit-Ville
5 USA";

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives

16 Daniel Malott, Abel Johnson, and Kayden Allison on their outstanding
17 and well-deserved State Championship victory; and

27 in all their future endeavors.
