AN ACT Relating to the uniform unsworn declarations act; amending RCW 5.50.010, 5.50.020, 5.50.050, 5.50.900, and 5.50.901; and repealing RCW 9A.72.085.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 5.50.010 and 2011 c 22 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 In this chapter:

8 (1) (("Boundaries of the United States" means the geographic 9 boundaries of the United States, Puerto Rico, the United States 10 Virgin Islands, and any territory or insular possession subject to 11 the jurisdiction of the United States.

12 (2)) "Law" includes ((the federal or a state Constitution,)) a 13 ((federal or state)) statute, ((a)) judicial decision or order, ((a)) 14 rule of court, ((an)) executive order, and ((an)) administrative 15 rule, regulation, or order.

16 (((3))) (2) "Record" means information that is inscribed on a 17 tangible medium or that is stored in an electronic or other medium 18 and is retrievable in perceivable form.

19 (((4))) <u>(3)</u> "Sign" means, with present intent to authenticate or 20 adopt a record:

21 (a) To execute or adopt a tangible symbol; or

1 (b) To attach to or logically associate with the record an 2 electronic symbol, sound, or process.

3 (((5) "State" means a state of the United States, the District of 4 Columbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, or any 5 territory or insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the 6 United States.

7 (6)) (4) "Sworn declaration" means a declaration in a signed
8 record given under oath. The term includes a sworn statement,
9 verification, certificate, and affidavit.

10 (((7))) (5) "Unsworn declaration" means a declaration in a signed 11 record ((that is)) not given under oath((r)) but ((is)) given under 12 penalty of perjury.

13 Sec. 2. RCW 5.50.020 and 2011 c 22 s 3 are each amended to read 14 as follows:

15 This chapter applies to an unsworn declaration by a declarant who 16 at the time of making the declaration is physically located within or outside the boundaries of the United States, whether or not the 17 location is subject to the jurisdiction of the United States. ((This 18 chapter does not apply to a declaration by a declarant who is 19 physically located on property that is within the boundaries of the 20 United States and subject to the jurisdiction of another country or a 21 22 federally recognized Indian tribe.))

23 Sec. 3. RCW 5.50.050 and 2011 c 22 s 6 are each amended to read 24 as follows:

25 An unsworn declaration under this chapter must be in 26 substantially the following form:

I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct((, and that I am physically located outside the geographic boundaries of the United States, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, and any territory or insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the United States)).

5 Sec. 4. RCW 5.50.900 and 2011 c 22 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 This chapter may be cited as the uniform unsworn ((foreign)) 8 declarations act.

9 Sec. 5. RCW 5.50.901 and 2011 c 22 s 7 are each amended to read 10 as follows:

11 In applying and construing this uniform act <u>and chapter</u>, 12 consideration must be given to the need to promote uniformity of the 13 law with respect to its subject matter among states that enact it.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. RCW 9A.72.085 (Unsworn statements, 15 certification—Standards for subscribing to an unsworn statement) and 16 2014 c 93 s 4 & 1981 c 187 s 3 are each repealed.

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
