- AN ACT Relating to names used by candidates in elections; and amending RCW 29A.24.060.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29A.24.060 and 2003 c 111 s 606 are each amended to read as follows:
- When filing for office, a candidate <u>shall file using the name</u> appearing on the candidate's voter registration. A candidate may,
- 8 <u>separately</u> indicate the manner in which ((he or she)) the candidate
- 9 desires ((his or her)) the first, or given, name to be printed on the
- 10 ballot. For ((filing purposes)) the ballot, a candidate may use a
- 11 nickname by which ((he or she is)) <u>the candidate is</u> commonly known
- 12 ((as his or her first name, but the last name shall be the name under
- 13 which he or she is registered to vote)).
- 14 No candidate may:
- 15 (1) Use a nickname that denotes present or past occupation,
- 16 including military rank;
- 17 (2) Use a nickname that denotes the candidate's position on 18 issues or political affiliation;
- 19 (3) Use a nickname designed intentionally to mislead voters;
