1 AN ACT Relating to requiring the governor to provide background  
2 check information regarding gubernatorial appointees; and amending  
3 RCW 43.06.030.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.06.030 and 1981 c 338 s 12 are each amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 For a gubernatorial appointment to be effective, the governor  
8 must:

9 (1) Use a background check to screen the appointee in a uniform  
10 and timely manner to verify that the appointee does not have a  
11 history that would disqualify the appointee. At a minimum, the  
12 background check must include a name and date of birth check for a  
13 conviction record, as defined in RCW 10.97.030; and

14 (2) Transmit to the secretary of the senate notice of the  
15 appointment, along with pertinent information regarding the  
16 appointee, within fourteen days after making any appointment subject  
17 to senate confirmation. Pertinent information must include, but is  
18 not limited to, verification that a background check has been  
19 completed under subsection (1) of this section. If the applicant has  
20 a conviction record or if the screening reveals other information  
21 that was considered as part of the appointment, the office of the

1 governor must make that information available to the senate for  
2 consideration.
