- 1 AN ACT Relating to the use of state funds for medical

- 3 treatment services; and adding a new section to chapter 71.24 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 71.24 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) It is the intent of the legislature to provide access to the 8 full complement of substance use disorder treatment services 9 available under the state medicaid plan in adequate amounts within
- each regional service area established under RCW 74.09.870 to the extent feasible. This section does not require the state to provide
- 12 secure withdrawal management and stabilization facility services
- 13 under chapter 71.05 RCW within each regional service area before July
- 14 1, 2026.
- 15 (2) State funding may not be used to provide medical
- 16 transportation to a person for substance use disorder treatment
- 17 services located outside their home regional service area unless
- 18 there is no equivalent service offered within the person's regional
- 19 service area.

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
