- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 Substitute teachers and other employees who work an intermittent
- 8 unspecified workweek are not eligible for benefits through the school
- 9 employees' benefits board.
- 10 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 41.05
- 11 RCW to read as follows:
- 12 Retired school employees receiving benefits under the public
- 13 employees' benefits board are not eligible for benefits through the
- 14 school employees' benefits board.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05
- 16 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 (1) Employees receiving coverage under the school employees'
- 18 benefits board may not be an eligible dependent of an employee
- 19 obtaining benefits under the public employees' benefits board.

- 1 (2) Employees receiving coverage under the public employees'
- 2 benefits board may not be an eligible dependent of an employee
- 3 obtaining benefits under the school employees' benefits board.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act applies to school employee
- 5 benefits beginning on or after September 1, 2021.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** This act takes effect July 1, 2021.
