1 AN ACT Relating to requiring local ballot measure statement 2 committee members to be registered voters in the area voting on the 3 measure; and amending RCW 29A.32.280.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 29A.32.280 and 2015 c 146 s 3 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 For each measure from a unit of local government that is included 8 in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall, not later than the resolution deadline, formally 9 appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval 10 of the measure and shall formally appoint a committee to prepare 11 arguments advocating voters' rejection of the measure. The authority 12 13 shall appoint persons known to favor the measure to serve on the 14 committee advocating approval and shall, whenever possible, appoint 15 persons known to oppose the measure to serve on the committee 16 advocating rejection. Each committee shall have not more than three 17 members, however, a committee may seek the advice of any person or 18 persons. Each member of the committee must be a registered voter in the area voting on the measure. If the legislative authority of a 19 20 unit of local government fails to make such appointments by the

- 1 prescribed deadline, the county auditor shall whenever possible make
- 2 the appointments.
