- 1 AN ACT Relating to providing a designation on a driver's license
- 2 or identicard that a person has a developmental disability; adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 46.20 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.20 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A developmentally disabled person, as defined in RCW 8 71A.10.020, may apply to the department to obtain a developmentally 9 disabled designation on a driver's license or identicard issued under 10 this section by providing self-attestation that the individual has a 11 developmental disability.
- 12 (2) The developmentally disabled designation must be provided to 13 eligible individuals at no additional cost beyond other applicable 14 driver's license or identicard fees required by law.
- 15 (3) The department, jointly with the department of social and 16 health services, must develop procedures to allow individuals to 17 apply for the developmentally disabled designation in the most efficient and convenient manner possible. The procedures must include 18 19 public information regarding the ability to apply for the 20 developmentally disabled designation on a driver's license or 21 identicard.
