- AN ACT Relating to providing additional funding for the business licensing service program administered by the department of revenue;
- 3 amending RCW 19.02.075; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.02.075 and 2013 c 144 s 20 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department must collect a handling fee on each business 8 application and each renewal application filing. license department must set the amount of the handling fees by rule, as 9 10 authorized by RCW 19.02.030. The handling fees may not exceed 11 ((nineteen dollars for each business license application, and eleven)) eighty-five dollars for each business license application 12 filed by any person to open or reopen a business, ten dollars for 13 14 each business license renewal application filing, and nineteen 15 dollars for each business license application filed for any other 16 purpose, including obtaining a business license for an additional 17 <u>location of a new or existing business. Handling fees collected under</u> 18 this section must be deposited in the business license account
 - (2) The department may increase <u>all</u> handling ((and renewal)) fees within the limits provided in this section for the purposes of

- defraying the department's costs associated with the administration of this chapter, including making improvements in the business licensing service program, ((including)) such as improvements in technology and customer services, expanded access, and infrastructure.

 (3) Annually, by the last day of September, beginning September 30, 2023, the department must review the business license account
- 30, 2023, the department must review the business license account 7 balance at the end of the previous fiscal year. If the balance in the 8 account exceeds one million dollars or the department projects that 9 10 the balance in the business license account will exceed one million dollars at the end of the current fiscal year, the department must 11 reduce one or more of the handling fees authorized in subsection (1) 12 of this section. Handling fees must be reduced under this subsection 13 (3) to the extent the department determines necessary to result in a 14 balance in the business license account of no more than one million 15 dollars at the end of the next fiscal year as projected by the 16 17 department. This subsection (3) does not require the department to reduce handling fees more than once in any fiscal year. 18
- 19 (4) In increasing or decreasing any fee under this section, the
 20 department may round the adjusted fee to the nearest whole dollar
 21 that does not exceed the dollar limits in subsection (1) of this
 22 section.
- 23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 2020.
