- 9 making him a giant in the eyes of Alex Trebek and the history of
- 10 Jeopardy!; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Ken Jennings set a world record for most cash won on a
- 12 game show and a Jeopardy! record for the longest streak of wins; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Ken Jennings became known across the country as "the
- 14 Michael Jordan of trivia, the Seabiscuit of geekdom"; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Ken Jennings has a strong Kennection to Washington and
- 16 lives in the City of Seattle; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Ken Jennings is a prolific author and has shared his
- 18 genius with children through his Junior Genius Guides series; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Seattle Times readers are inspired by his choice in
- 20 books and all copies of "The New Dictionary of Cultural Literacy" are
- 21 currently on hold at local libraries; and
- 22 WHEREAS, If Jeopardy! gave out rings, he would certainly be a
