These efforts are necessary to ensure all residents have access to safe and affordable housing.

- 9 (b) The Legislature also finds that rent increases have slowed 10 down in recent years, and statewide data shows a slight decrease in 11 2023. However, localized variations and concerns about future rent 12 hikes persist, particularly for low- and moderate-income households. 13 Striking a balance between tenant protections and promoting continued 14 investments in housing production is crucial for long-term 15 affordability.
- 16 (c) Therefore, the legislature intents to enact a comprehensive 17 rent stabilization program that balances the need for increased 18 housing supply with the critical goal of ensuring housing 19 affordability for all residents. This program will establish fair and 20 predictable annual rent increase limits, protect tenants from eviction 21 without just cause, and promote investment in affordable housing 22 development"
