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- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The University of Washington's Runstad department of real estate shall conduct a study of the feasibility of a statewide transit-oriented development requirement. The study must include:
- 8 (a) A review and analysis of provisions for transit-oriented 9 development included in comprehensive plans and development 10 regulations by cities subject to the requirement under RCW 36.70A.
- 11 130 to update their comprehensive plans by December 31, 2024;
- 12 (b) A comparison of the transit-oriented development density, 13 regulations, and affordability requirements for each city reviewed; 14 and
- 15 (c) The convening of an expert panel on transit-oriented 16 development that includes representatives from local government, 17 transit agencies, affordable housing advocacy organizations, and 18 both non-profit and for-profit developers.
- 19 (2) By November 1, 2025, and in compliance with RCW 43.01.036, 20 the Runstad department of real estate shall submit a report to the 21 appropriate committees of the legislature that includes a comparison 22 of transit-oriented development practices in Washington cities and 23 any recommendations for statewide transit-oriented development 24 policies.
- 25 (3) This section expires December 1, 2025."

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27 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Removes all provisions in the underlying bill. Directs the University of Washington's Runstad Department of Real Estate (Runstad) to conduct a study of the feasibility of a statewide transit-oriented development requirement. Requires the study to include a review and comparison of transit-oriented development provisions in the comprehensive plans and development regulations of certain cities and consultation with an expert panel. Requires Runstad to submit a report with any recommendations to the Legislature by November 1, 2025.

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
