(a) Whether the disciplining authority for each profession should
2 be a board or a commission;

3 (b) The recommended membership of each board or commission, which 4 must include:

5 (i) A majority of members who are members of the regulated 6 professions; and

7 (ii) At least one public member;

8 (c) An estimate of the fiscal impact of changing the disciplining 9 authority for the professions; and

10 (d) A transition plan for changing the disciplining authorities,11 including recommended statutory changes.

12 (3) When formulating the findings and recommendations, the 13 secretary of health must consult with organizations representing the 14 professions regulated under chapter 18.225 RCW.

15 (4) The secretary of health shall report the findings and 16 recommendations to the appropriate committees of the legislature no 17 later than July 1, 2025.

18 (5) This section expires August 1, 2025."

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20 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any 21 internal references accordingly.

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EFFECT: Requires the Secretary of Health to consult with the Washington State Mental Health Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, and Social Workers Advisory Committee when adopting rules relating to continuing education for those professions. Requires the Secretary of Health to study and make recommendations on creating new disciplining authorities for each of the following professions: mental health counselors, marriage & family therapists, and clinical social workers.
