- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. This act may be known and cited as the
- 4 Richard Lenhart act.
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9A.52
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A person is guilty of school bus trespass if he or she
- 8 knowingly and maliciously:
- 9 (a) Enters or remains unlawfully in a school bus;
- 10 (b) Does any other act that creates a substantial risk of harm to passengers or the driver; and
- 12 (c) Causes a substantial interruption or impairment to services 13 rendered by the school bus.
- 14 (2) As used in this section, "school bus" means any vehicle 15 owned, leased, or operated by a public school district, a religious 16 or private school, a private entity contracted with a school 17 district, or educational institution for the purpose of transporting 18 students to and from school or school-related activities.
- 19 (3) School bus trespass is a gross misdemeanor.
- 20 (4) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to any of the 21 following:
- 22 (a) Students enrolled in the school which is being serviced by 23 the school bus;
- 24 (b) Law enforcement officers or other authorized personnel 25 engaged in the performance of their official duties;
- (c) Individuals with written consent from the school district or educational institution allowing them to enter or remain on the school bus; and
- 29 (d) Emergency situations where entering the bus is necessary to 30 protect the safety or well-being of students or others.

- 1 (5) Local law enforcement agencies shall have the authority to enforce the provisions of this act. School districts and educational institutions shall collaborate with local law enforcement to 3 establish protocols and procedures to ensure effective enforcement of 4 this act. 5
 - (6) School districts and educational institutions shall implement educational programs and awareness campaigns to educate students, parents, and the community about the importance of maintaining safety and security on school buses. These educational programs shall emphasize the potential consequences of school bus trespassing in accordance with this act.
 - (7) Subject to the availability of funds appropriated for this specific purpose, school districts and educational institutions shall affix placards warning of the consequences of violating subsection (1) of this section on the outside of all public school buses in a manner easily visible for all to see.
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 18 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 19 20 persons or circumstances is not affected."

> EFFECT: Makes school bus trespass a gross misdemeanor instead of a class C felony and removes the seriousness level for the offense. Provides that the offense of school bus trespass does not apply to any students enrolled in the school being serviced by the school bus.
