1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 79A.05.015 and 1999 c 249 s 201 are each amended to 4 read as follows:

5 There is hereby created a "state parks and recreation commission" 6 consisting of seven citizens of the state. The members of the commission shall be appointed by the governor by and with the advice 7 and consent of the senate and shall serve for a term of six years, 8 expiring on December 31st of even-numbered years, and until their 9 successors are appointed. In case of a vacancy, the governor shall 10 fill the vacancy for the unexpired term of the commissioner whose 11 12 office has become vacant.

13 In making the appointments to the commission, the governor 14 ((shall)) should strive to choose citizens who are representative of the diversity of Washington, who understand park and recreation needs 15 16 and interests, and who are from different regions of the state. The members of the commission should include a variety of citizens with 17 different gender, ethnic, racial, and tribal backgrounds, including 18 19 citizens with other lived experiences. No person shall serve if ((he 20 or she)) the person holds any elective or full-time appointive state, 21 county, or municipal office. Members of the commission shall be 22 compensated in accordance with RCW 43.03.240 and in addition shall be 23 allowed their travel expenses incurred while absent from their usual 24 places of residence in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.

25 Payment of expenses pertaining to the operation of the commission 26 shall be made upon vouchers certified to by such persons as shall be 27 designated by the commission."
