- 1 AN ACT Relating to health care plans administered by the health
- 2 care authority that are available to medicare eligible retirees;
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 41.05 RCW; and creating a new
- 4 section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.05
 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 The public employees' benefits board must allow medicare eligible
- 9 retirees access to the uniform medical plan classic medicare.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) The legislature recognizes that the
- 11 health care authority, consistent with the public employees' benefits
- 12 board resolution 2022-16, will consult with active employees and
- 13 retirees, by conducting listening sessions and facilitating public
- 14 forums, to gather feedback about member needs and to explore more
- 15 affordable government self-insured plans with benefits that are equal
- 16 to or richer than uniform medical plan classic medicare. As such, the
- 17 legislature intends that the results of stakeholder engagements will
- 18 be used to inform future health care plan selection.

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- 1 (2) By December 1, 2023, the authority must report to the 2 legislature with its findings of the stakeholder engagements in 3 subsection (1) of this section.
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
