5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.32.4992 and 2023 c 397 s 3 are each amended to 7 read as follows:

8 (1) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the 9 teachers' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2017, shall receive, 10 effective July 1, 2018, an increase to their monthly benefit of one 11 and one-half percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly 12 benefit, not to exceed \$62.50.

13 (2) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the 14 teachers' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2019, shall receive, 15 effective July 1, 2020, an increase to their monthly benefit of three 16 percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to 17 exceed \$62.50.

(3) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the
teachers' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2021, shall receive,
effective July 1, 2022, an increase to their monthly benefit of three

1 percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to 2 exceed \$110.00.

3 (4) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the 4 teachers' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2022, shall receive, 5 effective July 1, 2023, an increase to their monthly benefit of three 6 percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to 7 exceed \$110.00.

8 (5) <u>Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the</u> 9 <u>teachers' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2023, shall receive,</u> 10 <u>effective July 1, 2024, an increase to their monthly benefit of three</u> 11 <u>percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to</u> 12 <u>exceed \$110.00.</u>

13 <u>(6)</u> This section does not apply to those receiving benefits 14 pursuant to RCW 41.32.489 or 41.32.540.

15 Sec. 2. RCW 41.40.1987 and 2023 c 397 s 4 are each amended to 16 read as follows:

(1) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the public employees' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2017, shall receive, effective July 1, 2018, an increase to their monthly benefit of one and one-half percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to exceed \$62.50.

(2) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the public employees' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2019, shall receive, effective July 1, 2020, an increase to their monthly benefit of three percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to exceed \$62.50.

(3) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the public employees' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2021, shall receive, effective July 1, 2022, an increase to their monthly benefit of three percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, not to exceed \$110.00.

32 (4) Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the 33 public employees' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2022, shall 34 receive, effective July 1, 2023, an increase to their monthly benefit 35 of three percent multiplied by the beneficiaries' monthly benefit, 36 not to exceed \$110.00.

37 (5) <u>Beneficiaries who are receiving a monthly benefit from the</u> 38 <u>public employees' retirement system plan 1 on July 1, 2023, shall</u> 39 <u>receive, effective July 1, 2024, an increase to their monthly benefit</u>
