State of Washington 69th Legislature 2025 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to school director districts; amending RCW 2 28A.343.300; adding a new section to chapter 28A.343 RCW; and 3 creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 The legislature finds that students and NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. 6 communities benefit from diverse school boards of directors that are 7 representative of the communities and neighborhoods they serve. 8 Furthermore, the legislature recognizes proportional representation 9 encourages greater school board diversity, and more parents of 10 school-aged children to seek office than at-large district elections. 11 Therefore, the legislature intends to require school districts with 12 enrollments greater than 3,000 students to elect school board 13 directors from designated member districts.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28A.343
15 RCW to read as follows:

16 (1) By calendar year 2027, all elections of directors of any 17 school district with a head count enrollment greater than 3,000 18 students shall elect school board directors from designated member 19 districts accordingly:

(a) For districts with a head count enrollment greater than 5,000
 students, no less than four school board directors shall be elected
 by designated member districts; and

4 (b) For districts with a head count enrollment of 3,001 to 5,000
5 students, no less than three school board directors shall be elected
6 by designated member districts.

7 (2) School districts with 3,000 students or less are exempt from8 this section.

9 Sec. 3. RCW 28A.343.300 and 2009 c 107 s 1 are each amended to 10 read as follows:

11 The governing board of a school district shall be known as the 12 board of directors of the district.

Unless otherwise specifically provided, as in RCW 29A.04.340 and 13 section 2 of this act, each member of a board of directors shall be 14 15 elected by ballot by the registered voters of the school district and 16 shall hold office for a term of four years and until a successor is elected and qualified. Terms of school directors shall be staggered, 17 and insofar as possible, not more than a majority of one shall be 18 elected to full terms at any regular election. In case a member or 19 20 members of a board of directors are to be elected to fill an 21 unexpired term or terms, the ballot shall specify the term for which each such member is to be elected. 22

Except for a school district of the first class having within its boundaries a city with a population of ((four hundred thousand)) <u>400,000</u> people or more which shall have a board of directors of seven members, the board of directors of every school district of the first class or school district of the second class shall consist of five members.
