- 1 AN ACT Relating to facilitating the prompt replacement of 2 defective continuous glucose monitoring equipment; and adding a new 3 section to chapter 18.64 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.64 6 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) A pharmacy in a physical location that dispenses continuous glucose monitoring equipment shall maintain a sufficient supply of monitoring sensors to enable the pharmacy to provide a same-day replacement sensor to a patient who experiences an equipment malfunction or an emergency that necessitates an additional sensor to be dispensed.
 - (2) A mail-order pharmacy that dispenses continuous glucose monitoring equipment shall maintain a sufficient supply of monitoring sensors to enable the pharmacy to promptly provide a replacement sensor to a patient who experiences an equipment malfunction or an emergency that necessitates an additional sensor to be dispensed. For purposes of this subsection, "promptly" means mailing a replacement sensor to the patient no later than the next business day or, if
