- 196-09-120 Meetings and officers.

WAC 196-09-120 Meetings and officers. All meetings of the board are held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, chapter 42.30 RCW. The Washington state board of registration for professional engineers and land surveyors shall hold its annual meeting in the third week of June each year. All other meetings of the board are held at such times and places as the board may deem necessary.

At the annual meeting the board shall elect a chair and vice-chair to hold office for one year commencing July 9. Any resignation from the position of chair shall be filled for the remainder of the term by the vice-chair.

- 196-25-070 Providing direct supervision.

WAC 196-25-070 Providing direct supervision. **Direct supervision** means the actions by which a licensee maintains control over those decisions that are the basis for the findings, conclusions, analyses, rationale, details, and judgments required for the preparation of engineering or land surveying plans, specifications, plats, reports, and related activities. **Direct supervision** requires providing personal direction, oversight, inspection, observation and supervision of the work being certified.

These actions may include, but are not limited to: Direct face-to-face communications; written communications; U.S. mail; electronic mail; facsimiles; telecommunications, or other current technology. Contractual or employment rela-

tions must be in place between the licensee and unlicensed preparer to qualify as direct supervision. Mentoring is not direct supervision. Drawing or other document review after preparation without involvement in the design and development process as described above cannot be accepted as direct supervision.
