

WAC 110-305-3635 When handwashing is required. (1) Program staff must wash hands:

- (a) Upon arriving to the program;
 - (b) After personal toileting or assisting a child with toileting;
 - (c) Before and after giving medication or applying topical ointment;
 - (d) After attending to an ill or injured child;
 - (e) After contact with bodily fluids;
 - (f) Before preparing, serving, or eating food;
 - (g) When returning from playground/outside;
 - (h) After handling garbage and garbage receptacles;
 - (i) Before and after handling or feeding pets/animals;
 - (j) After smoking; and
 - (k) As needed when hands are soiled.
- (2) Children must wash their hands:
- (a) Upon arrival to the program;
 - (b) When returning from playground and/or outside;
 - (c) Before the child eats;
 - (d) Before the child participates in food activities;
 - (e) After the child's toileting;
 - (f) Before and after handling or feeding pets/animals;
 - (g) After touching bodily fluids, including after sneezing or coughing; and
 - (h) As needed when hands are soiled.
