

WAC 110-730-0080 Documenting and reporting violations committed by juveniles in residential facilities. (1) All serious violations and violations listed in WAC 388-730-0070(2) must be documented in an incident report. The incident report must include:

- (a) Circumstances leading up to the violation(s);
 - (b) A description of the violation;
 - (c) Response by staff;
 - (d) Response by the juvenile(s) involved in the incident; and
 - (e) Sanctions imposed or recommended for the violation(s).
- (2) Service providers must:

- (a) Forward all incident reports to the JRA program administrator no later than twenty-four hours after the behavior is discovered; and
- (b) Verbally report serious violations to the JRA program administrator immediately.
