WAC 388-106-1021 What days are considered holidays for private duty nursing providers? The following dates are holidays solely for the purpose of contracted services rates for private duty nursing providers:

- (1) The first day of January (New Year's Day);
- (2) The third Monday of January (Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birth-day);
  - (3) The third Monday of February (Presidents' Day);
  - (4) The last Monday of May (Memorial Day);
  - (5) The 19th day of June (Juneteenth);
  - (6) The fourth day of July (Independence Day);
  - (7) The first Monday in September (Labor Day);
  - (8) The 11th day of November (Veteran's Day);
  - (9) The fourth Thursday in November (Thanksgiving Day);
- (10) The Friday immediately following the fourth Thursday in November (Native American Heritage Day); and
  - (11) The 25th day of December (Christmas Day).
