

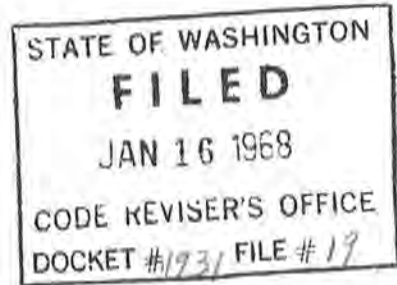

REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE USE OF INSECTICIDES  
ON CORN IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY



Notice 1031

I, Donald W. Moos, Director of Agriculture, of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 17.21 and 15.57 RCW, after due notice as provided under Chapters 34.04 and 42.32 RCW, and a public hearing held in Othello on December 21, 1967, do hereby promulgate the following regulations relating to the restricted use of insecticides on corn actively shedding pollen.

Regulation 1. Definition: The term "actively shedding pollen" as related to any given corn field regulated under this Order shall be that stage of growth when 10 percent or more of the corn plants in any one quarter portion of that field are showing spike anthers.

The symbols, "T", "N", "R", and "E", as related to this Order shall be defined as follows: T means Township, N means North, R means Range, and E means East of Willamette Meridian.


Regulation 2. Restricted Use Insecticides. The agricultural insecticides 1-Naphthyl-n-methyl carbamate, hereafter referred to as Carbaryl (Sevin); O,O-diethyl O-p-nitrophenyl phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Parathion; O,O-dimethyl O-p-nitrophenyl phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Methyl Parathion; O,O-dimethyl dithiophosphate of diethyl mercaptosuccinate, hereafter referred to as Malathion; Hexachlorohexahydromethano-2,4,3-benzodioxathiepin oxide, hereafter referred to as Endosulfan (Thiodan); and O,O-diethyl O-(2-isopropyl-4-methyl-6-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Diazinon; are by this Order declared to be restricted use insecticides. Such insecticides are restricted in their use in certain designated areas of Walla Walla County in the State of Washington.

Regulation 3. Area Number 1: The southern portion of Walla Walla County 19 miles long and 8½ miles wide lying adjacent to the Oregon border from Mojonier Road on the East to a line at Reese on the West. Sections 2 through 11, 14 through 21, those portions of Sections 22, 23, 27, and 28 North of State Road No. 3, Sections 29, 30, 31, 32, T7N, R35E; Sections 5,6,7, and 8, and those portions of Sections 9, 16, 17, and 18 lying West of Mojonier Road and in Walla Walla County, T6N, R35E; Section 1 through 12 and those portions of Sections 13 through 18 lying in Walla Walla County, T6N, R34E; Sections 1 through 12 and those portions of Sections 13 through 18

lying in Walla Walla County, T6N, R33E; All of T7N, R34E and all of T7N, R33E; Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35, and 36, T7N, R32E; Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, and those portions of 13 and 14 lying in Walla Walla County, T6N, R32E.

Area 1. Restrictions: The use of Carbaryl (Sevin), Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen is prohibited. The application of Malathion, Diazinon, and Endosulfan (Thiodan) on corn that is actively shedding pollen is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M.
