REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO BLOSSOMING ALFALFA, CLOVER, AND MINT

I, Donald W. Moos, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapters 17.21 and 15.57 RCW, after due notice as provided under Chapters 34.04 and 42.32 RCW, and a public hearing held in Yakima on February 4, 1971, do hereby promulgate the following regulations relating to the use and application of restricted use pesticides on blossoming alfalfa, clover, and mint.

REGULATION 1. DEFINITIONS. The term "blossoming alfalfa or clover" as used in this order shall be when there are five or more blooms per square yard on the average in a given field: PROVIDED, That following the first cutting the bloom count shall be taken only on the current crop. For the purpose of this regulation, a "bloom" is defined as any clover head or alfalfa raceme containing one or more open flowers.

For the purpose of this order, the time of sunrise and sunset will be that of the official tables, U.S. Weather Bureau, Yakima, Washington.

REGULATION 2. RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDES. The following pesticides are by this order declared to be restricted use pesticides in all counties of the state of Washington: Aldrin, Azodrin, Banol, Baygon, Baytex, BHC, Bidrin, Biothion, Bomyl, Carzol, Chlordane, Dasanit, Diazinon, Dibrom, Dieltrin, Dilan, Dimethoate, Di-Syston, DDT, Delnav, Demeton, Dylox, Endrin, EPN, Ethion, Ethyl-Methyl Guthion, Folimet, Furidan, Gardona, Guthion, Heptachlor, Imidan, Isopropyl Parathion, Lannate, Lindane, Malathion, Matacil, Menazon, Metacide, Metasystox R, Methoxychlor, Methyl Parathion, Methyl Trithion, Morocide, NPD, Parathion, Perthane, Phorate, Phosdrin, Phosphamidon, Phostex, Phosvel, Sevin, TDE, TEPP, Thanite, Thiocron, Thiodan, Torak, Toxaphene, Trithion, Vapona, Zectran, and Zolone.

REGULATION 3. AREA UNDER ORDER. All counties of the state of Washington.

REGULATION 4. The use or application of any formulation (except where the formulation is specified) of the following pesticides shall be prohibited on blossoming alfalfa and clover crops: PROVIDED, That dust and spray formulations of Dieltrin and Sevin (Carbaryl) may be applied to alfalfa and clover crops only if applied seven days or more prior to blossoming:

REGULATION 5. The use or application of the following listed pesticides or any formulation thereof on blossoming alfalfa and clover crops is restricted to applications only within the period beginning at two hours prior to sunset and ending at two and one-half hours after sunrise the following morning: PROVIDED, That Endrin, Lannate, and Gardona may only be applied to blossoming clover crops pursuant to this regulation and their application to blossoming alfalfa is further restricted to applications only within the period beginning at two hours prior to sunset and ending at midnight the same day: PROVIDED FURTHER, That the application of the following restricted use pesticides on blossoming alfalfa in Walla Walla County is further restricted to applications only within the period beginning at sunset and ending at 2:00 a.m. the following morning:



REGULATION 6. The use or application of wettable powder formulations of Dibrom (Naled) and emulsifiable, liquid, or wettable powder formulations of Malathion and Phorate applied as sprays on blossoming alfalfa or clover crops is restricted to applications only within the period beginning at two hours prior to sunset and ending at midnight of the same day.

REGULATION 7. The use or application of Malathion and TEPP on blossoming mint crops is restricted to applications only within the period beginning at two hours prior to sunset and ending at two and one-half hours after sunrise the following morning.

REGULATION 8. Aircraft carrying restricted use pesticides are prohibited from turning and/or low flying over cities, towns, or residences belonging to any person other than the owner of the property being treated, EXCEPT by permission of the person whose residence is involved.
