ORDER NO. 574

(Superseding Order No. 421 and 457)

AN ORDER RELATING TO THE CLEANING AND WASHING OF EQUIPMENT
USED IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF LIVE POULTRY AND TURKEYS

I, Sverre N. Omdahl, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under sections 3110 and 3113 of Remington's Revised Statutes, do make and issue the following regulations:

Regulation 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to ship, transport, or otherwise convey any live poultry, turkeys or other fowl, other than baby chicks and poults, in any crate, coop or other container, unless the crate, coop, or other container has been thoroughly cleaned and thereafter washed with water or steam under pressure between each and every consignment of poultry, turkeys or other fowl to the receiving station or point of destination.

Regulation 2. All common carriers, trucks and other conveyances used in the transportation of live poultry, turkeys and other fowl to or from the receiving station or point of destination must be free from poultry or turkey droppings, feathers and other debris.

PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this order shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
