REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION AND USE OF  
BIOLOGICAL PRODUCTS WITHIN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

I Sverre N. Omdahl, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under sections 3110 and 3113 of Remington's Revised Statutes, do make and issue the following regulations providing for the sale, distribution and use of biological products in the State of Washington.

Regulation 1. All biological products sold within the state or imported into the State of Washington for sale, distribution or use shall be produced under a license issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry, United States Department of Agriculture, or other license recognized by the State Department of Agriculture.

Regulation 2. All live vaccines or attenuated vaccines used for immunizing animals against disease shall be administered by authorized inspectors of the United States Bureau of Animal Industry, veterinarians duly licensed to practice in the State of Washington or by persons who have secured permits from the State Department of Agriculture for the use of live vaccines or attenuated vaccines, PROVIDED, that this regulation does not apply to poultry.

Regulation 3. No live vaccines or attenuated vaccines shall be shipped into the State of Washington or sold for distribution except to veterinarians duly licensed to practice in the State of Washington or to veterinary inspectors of the United States Bureau of Animal Industry, except on permit from the State Department of Agriculture, PROVIDED, That this regulation does not apply to poultry.

Regulation 4. Veterinarians administering any live vaccines or attenuated vaccines shall immediately render full report to the Director of Agriculture, giving names and addresses of owners and number and kind of animals treated, PROVIDED, That this regulation does not apply to poultry.

**PENALTY:** Any person, firm or corporation violating any of these regulations shall be guilty of a violation of the law and punished as by statute provided.

All biological products sold within the state or imported into the State of Washington for sale, distribution or use shall be produced under a license issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry, United States Department of Agriculture, or other license recognized by the State Department of Agriculture, or by special permit from the State Department of Agriculture.
