Effective April 15, 1950

A REGULATION RELATING TO THE DECHARACTERIZATION OF HORSE MEAT
USED OTHER THAN FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION

I, Sverre N. Omdahl, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 17, Chapter 100, Session Laws of 1949, do make and issue the following regulations relating to the decharacterization of horse meat used other than for human consumption:

Regulation 1. Proper decharacterization of horse meat shall mean a complete and unmistakable change in color to green or black by the use of edible fast green dye or powdered charcoal.

Regulation 2. Any person violating the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
