REVISION OF WASHINGTON STANDARDS FOR APPLES - Golden Delicious Variety

In accordance with Section 2855, R. R. S., an official grade and pack hearing was held in Wenatchee, Washington, on February 24, 1950, at which time the growers of Golden Delicious variety of apples voted in favor of the following changes:

Under Washington Standards for Apples, May 1939, insert under GREEN OR YELLOW VARIETIES Golden Delicious "75% characteristic color" under "Fancy" Grade, and delete the present definition for "characteristic color" and insert the following:


"In the Golden Delicious Variety, when the white color around the lenticels predominates over the green color, creating a mottling effect on the surface of the apple, it shall be considered as the minimum 'characteristic color'."


Under BOX PACKS, following the first paragraph, insert the following:

"Standard box packs of Golden Delicious shall be well filled or fairly well filled at the time of packing."

This order shall take effect at the beginning of the apple season.
