Mr. Fred Ramsey, Administrator of the Washington State Potato Commission and acting under the authority of the Washington State Potato Commission, presented the following statement:



AMD

WAC 16-516-125 PENALTY ASSESSMENT. Pursuant to authority granted by 15.66.170 RCW and by WAC 16-516-020 (8), in the event that any assessment is not paid within 90 days after the date of the billing therefore by the commission, or within 90 days after the due date of the report required by WAC 16-516-110 (b) iii and iv, a sum equal to 10% of such unpaid assessment of unpaid portion thereof shall be added thereto and be due and owing to the commission.
