A REGULATION RELATING TO RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDES

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 249, Laws of 1961 (Chapter 17.21 RCW) after due notice and public hearings held at Dayton, Washington on October 18, 1961, Walla Walla, Washington on October 17, 1961, Pomeroy, Washington on October 18, 1961, Spokane, Washington on November 16, 1961, Colfax, Washington on November 15, 1961, Okanogan, Washington on November 28, 1961, Trinidad, Washington on November 29, 1961, Kennewick, Washington on December 5, 1961, Pasco, Washington on December 5, 1961, and Prosser, Washington on December 6, 1961 (pursuant to 42.32.010 and 34.04.020 RCW), do hereby promulgate the following regulation:

Regulation 1. The herbicides known as 2,4-D, 2,4,5-T, and M.C.P. or any formulation thereof with any other herbicides, chemicals salts or water except the amine, sodium or solubilized acid formulations which have been found and determined subsequent to hearings to be injurious on any crops, shrubs or lands other than the agricultural pests they are intended to prevent, destroy, control, or mitigate and are declared to be "Restricted Use Pesticides" in the counties of Columbia, Walla Walla, Garfield, Spokane, Whitman, Okanogan, Douglas, Chelan, Grant, Benton, Franklin, and Yakima.
