Amending and Adding a New Regulation to Order No. 790

Effective September 1, 1962

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 90, Laws of 1937 (Chapter 22.08, RCW) after due notice as provided under Chapter 34.04 and 42.32, RCW and a public hearing held in Olympia on June 19, 1962, do promulgate the following regulation supplementing Order No. 790 relating to inspection, grading, and weighing fees.

Regulation 11. Amending Order No. 790, Regulation 7, Section 2.

Section 2. Inspection of Beans, Peas and similar commodities (minimum charge \$4.00).

1. Inspection of bags of 100 lbs. or equivalent .....per bag..... \$ .02
2. Inspection, bulk....per 100 lbs..... \$ .02
3. Submitted sample inspection...per sample. \$4.00

Regulation 12. Sampling, Testing and Certification of Wheat for Sedimentation Values.

1. Sampling and certification of identifiable lots..... \$5.00
2. Reinspection...file sample or lot..... \$5.00
3. Submitted sample certification..... \$5.00
4. For sampling service only, to provide a sedimentation sample.....  
....per hour....(minimum, 1 hour)..... \$3.00
