REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE USE OF INSECTICIDES
ON CORN

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 17.21, RCW, after due notice as provided under Chapter 34.04 and 42.32, RCW, and a public hearing held in Yakima on December 19, 1962, do promulgate the following regulations relating to the restricted use of insecticides on corn actively shedding pollen.

Regulation 1. Definition: The term "actively shedding pollen" as related to corn in this Order shall be that stage of growth when 10% or more of the corn plants in a field are showing spike anthers.

Regulation 2. Restricted Insecticides. The agricultural insecticides 1-Naphthyl-n-methyl carbamate, hereafter referred to as Sevin; O, O-diethyl O-p-nitrophenyl thiophosphate, hereafter referred to as Parathion; O, O-dimethyl O-p-nitrophenyl phosphorothioate, hereafter referred to as Methyl Parathion; and S-(1,2-dicarbethoxyethyl) O, O-dimethyl dithiophosphate, hereafter referred to as Malathion; are by this Order declared to be restricted use insecticides. Such insecticides are restricted in their use in certain designated areas of Yakima and Benton counties of the State of Washington.

Regulation 3. Area Number 1. (Early Corn Area) This area includes all of the irrigable lands East of a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 9, Township 7 North, Range 22 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North to the Bond Road and following the Bond Road Northerly 4 miles, more or less, to Highway 3A; thence Northwest 3 miles, more or less, along Highway 3A to a point 1/2 mile South of the Northwest corner of Section 19, TWN 9 N, R 22 E.W.M.; thence North 18 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 19, TWN 12 N, R 22 E.W.M. to a line beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 8, TWN 7 N, R 27 E.W.M.; thence North to the Weber Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Weber Canyon Road to Kiona and the Yakima River; thence Northerly along the Yakima River to the U.S. Military Reservation boundary at the Southwest corner of Section 19, TWN 10 N, R 27 E.W.M. In addition, all irrigable lands encompassed by a line starting at the Columbia River and the Southeast corner of Section 8, TWN 7 N, R 31 E.W.M.; thence West 5 miles, more or less, to the Nine Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Nine Canyon Road to the Haney Road; thence North on the Haney Road to the Bowles Road; thence Westerly on the Bowles Road to the Swayze Road; thence North on the Swayze Road to the Columbia River; thence Southeasterly along the Columbia River to the Southeast corner of Section 8, TWN 7 N, R 31 E.W.M., the point of beginning.

Area 1. (Restrictions) On and after August 1 of any given year, the use of Sevin, Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen is prohibited. On and after August 1 of any given year, the application of Malathion is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on corn that is actively shedding pollen: Provided, That prior to August 1 of any given year, this area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion on corn in any combination or formulation.

Regulation 4. Area Number 2. (Late Corn Area) This area includes all of the irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 7, TWN 7 N, R 21 E.W.M.; thence North 20 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, TWN 11 N, R 20 E.W.M. (Southern tip of Zillah); thence West to the junction of the Cheyne Road and Highway 410 (Northwest tip of Zillah); thence North on the Cheyne Road and its extension to the Northeast corner of Section 23 TWN 12 N, R 20 E.W.M.; thence East 7 miles, more or less, to the Northeast corner of Section 24, TWN 12 N, R 21 E.W.M.; thence South 18 miles, more or less, to Highway 3A;

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thence Southeast, following Highway 3A for 3 miles, more or less, to the Bond Road; thence Southerly on the Bond Road to its end; thence South to the Southwest corner of Section 9, TWN 7 N, R 22 E.W.M.; thence West 8 miles, more or less, to the Southwest corner of Section 7, TWN 7 N, R 21 E.W.M., the point of beginning.

Area 2. (Restrictions) Prior to August 15 of any given year, in the above described area, the application of Sevin, Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in any combination or formulation is prohibited on corn which is actively shedding pollen. Also prior to August 15, of any given year the application of Malathion is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on corn which is actively shedding pollen: PROVIDED, That on and after August 15 of any given year, this area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, Parathion, Methyl Parathion and Malathion on corn.


Regulation 5. Area Number 3. (Unrestricted) This area includes all irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 34, TWN 10 N, R 18 E.W.M.; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 22, TWN 12 N, R 18 E.W.M.; thence East 4 miles, more or less, to the Northern Pacific Railroad tracks; thence following the tracks Southeast to the Oldenway Road; thence North on the Oldenway Road and section lines to the Yakima River; thence Southeast along the Yakima River to Highway 97, North of Toppenish; thence North on Highway 97 to Highway 410 at Buena; thence Southeasterly along Highway 410 to the Southeast corner of Section 36, TWN 11 N, R 20 E.W.M. (Southern tip of Zillah); thence South 6 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 36, TWN 10 N, R 20 E.W.M.; thence 15 miles West, more or less, to the Southwest corner of Section 34, TWN 10 N, R 18 E.W.M., the point of beginning. Also all irrigable lands lying within Benton County, East of a line beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 8, TWN 7 N, R 27 E.W.M.; thence North to the Weber Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Weber Canyon Road to Kiona and the Yakima River, thence Northerly along the Yakima River to the U.S. Military Reservation at the Southwest corner of Section 19, TWN 10 N, R 27 E.W.M.; to a line starting at the South section line of Section 9, TWN 7 N, R 30 E.W.M. and the Nine Canyon Road; thence Northerly along the Nine Canyon Road to the Haney Road; thence North on the Haney Road to the Bowles Road; thence Westerly on the Bowles Road to the Swayze Road; thence North on the Swayze Road to the Columbia River.

Area 3. (Restrictions) This area is unrestricted as to the use of Sevin, Parathion, Methyl Parathion, and Malathion in any combination or formulation, on corn.

Regulation 6. Area Number 4. (Restricted) This area includes all irrigable lands in the Yakima Indian Reservation West of a line starting at the Southwest corner of Section 34, TWN 10 N, R 18 E.W.M.; thence North 15 miles, more or less, to the Northwest corner of Section 22, TWN 12 N, R 18 E.W.M. Also all irrigable lands encompassed by a line beginning at a point $\frac{1}{2}$ mile East of the Northwest corner of Section 20, TWN 12 N, R 19 E.W.M.; thence Southeasterly along the Northern Pacific Railroad tracks to the Oldenway Road; thence North on the Oldenway Road and section lines to the Yakima River; thence Southeasterly along the Yakima River to Highway 97 North of Toppenish; thence North on Highway 97 to Highway 410 at Buena; thence Southeast along Highway 410 to the Cheyne Road; thence North on the Cheyne Road and its extention to the Northeast corner of Section 23, TWN 12 N, R 20 E.W.M.; thence West 10 miles, more or less, to a point $\frac{1}{2}$ mile East of the Northwest corner of Section 20, TWN 12 N, R 19 E.W.M., the point of beginning.

Area 4. (Restrictions) The use of Sevin, Parathion, and Methyl Parathion in any combination or formulation on corn which is actively shedding pollen is prohibited. The application of Malathion on corn that is actively shedding pollen is prohibited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.
