ORDER NO. 911


Effective March 18, 1963

The adoption of this Emergency Order No. 911 suspending all the provisions of Regulation 1 of Order No. 897 for a period of ninety days is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare. It is necessary that Order No. 911 become effective immediately to prevent confusion and undue disruption in the orderly marketing of packaged fluid dairy products.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 19.93 and 34.04 Revised Code of Washington do promulgate the following emergency regulation:

Regulation 1. All the provisions of Regulation 1, (a) through (c) of Order No. 897 concerning the packaging of fluid dairy products shall be suspended for a period of ninety days from the effective date of this order.
