Amending and Adding a New Regulation to Order No. 891

Effective July 7, 1963

I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 124, Laws of 1963 (Chapter 22.09, RCW) after due notice as provided under Chapter 34.04 and 42.32, RCW and a public hearing held in Spokane on May 23, 1963, do promulgate the following regulation supplementing Order No. 891 relating to warehouse bonding fees and inspection, grading, and weighing fees.


Regulation 1. Order No. 891, Regulation 11, Section 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Inspection of Beans, Peas and similar commodities
(minimum charge \$4.00)

1. Inspection of bags of 100 pounds or equivalent
.....per bag.....\$.91½
2. Terminal inspection point, bulk per ton \$.10
3. Submitted sample inspection..per sample..\$4.00

Regulation 2. A bond of not less than \$10,000 nor more than \$200,000 is required for each warehouse licensed pursuant to Chapter 124, Laws of 1963, the Washington Warehouse Act. The amount of such bond shall be computed at the rate of \$.12 per bushel of licensed storage capacity.
