NWCB Order Register (WAC 1-12-040)

A RESOLUTION Relating to emergency rules of the Noxious Weed Control Board.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL BOARD, STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Section 1. The annexed regulations, to wit: amending WAC 16-750-010, a proposed noxious weed list comprising the names of those plants which are found to be injurious to crops, livestock, or other property. I, Walter Wruble, find further than an emergency exists and that the foregoing order is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare and that observance of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views on the proposed action would be contrary to public interest. A statement of the facts constituting such emergency is: Notice of Intention to Adopt Rules was inadvertently prepared on wrong form and, thus, not accepted for filing by Code Reviser. Unable to schedule new meeting to meet 20-day notice requirements. The said rules are therefore adopted as emergency rules to take effect immediately

Section 2. This resolution and annexed regulations, after being first recorded as an administrative order in the Order Register of the Noxious Weed Control Board, shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to RCW 34.04.040 and WAC 1-12-050. Pursuant to RCW 17.10.080, a copy of the proposed list as amended shall also be sent to each activated county noxious weed control board and to the board of county commissioners of each county having an inactive noxious weed control board.
