EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 931

Effective August 6, 1963

ARCTIC APPLE SHIPMENTS


The adoption of this Emergency Order No. 931 establishing standards for certain apples being shipped for consumption within the area north of the 70th parallel (Arctic Circle) is necessary for the preservation of the general welfare. It is necessary that this Order become effective immediately in order that the Director provide proper standards for such apples.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joe Dwyer, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Chapter 122, Laws of 1963 and Chapter 34.04 Revised Code of Washington establish the following Standards for Apples.

Regulation 1. The factor of maturity as set forth in Order No. 893 shall not be controlling on grades for Red Sport varieties of Delicious, Standard Delicious, Golden Delicious, Winesap, Jonathan, and Yellow Newtown, when such apples are packed for shipment directly into and for consumption in the area north of the 70th parallel (Arctic Circle).

Regulation 2. Containers in which such apples are packed shall be stamped in the usual manner and in addition thereto shall be stamped with the word "Arctic" in letters of not less than one-half inch in height.
