RESOLUTION NO. 70- 4

WHEREAS, all state colleges, universities and community colleges are now excluded from the State Civil Service System, Chapter 41.06 RCW, and come within the provisions of the Higher Education Personnel Law, Chapter 36, Laws of 1969, First Extraordinary Session; and

WHEREAS, the Higher Education Personnel Board, duly established pursuant to the Higher Education Personnel Law, has adopted certain rules relating to classified personnel employed by state colleges and universities; and

WHEREAS, WAC 251-04-020(2) has defined "appointing authority" as "a person or group of persons lawfully authorized to make appointments"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 18 desires to denominate the appointing authority of Big Bend Community College and to delegate to such position denominated, the authority to appoint or terminate a classified employee appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 18 finds that the immediate adoption of this rule as expressed


in this resolution is necessary for the preservation of the general welfare and that observance of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views would be contrary to the public interest because no person at Big Bend Community College has yet been designated as an appointing authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the following position and the person occupying such position is deemed an appointing authority at Big Bend Community College: The President of Big Bend Community College.
2. The person occupying the position denominated in Paragraph 1 of this resolution is delegated by written order of authority to terminate, suspend or demote any classified employee at Big Bend Community College without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees. Additionally, such appointing authority previously denominated is authorized to make such appointments of eligible persons to classified positions at Big Bend Community College.

ADOPTED at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 18, State of Washington, held at Moses Lake, Washington, on February 3, 1970 with a quorum of such Trustees duly present after notice of such meeting was given pursuant to the provisions of State law.
