CHAPTER 132L-400 WAC
LOSS OF ELIGIBILITY--STUDENT ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION

NEW SECTION

WAC Chapter 132L-400-010 Immediate Suspension. When the college receives information that a student athlete has been convicted of a violation of chapter 69.41 RCW (Legend drugs--Prescription drugs) the student shall be immediately suspended from participation in school-sponsored athletic events by the director of athletics. The period of loss of eligibility to participate will be determined by the director of athletics at the conclusion of a brief adjudicative hearing, to be commenced within twenty days of the suspension.
